

MISSION TEAM

Team Leader: Marcus Dillon

Job description: Help purchase supplies for, plan, and/or organize mission projects including Serve Saturdays, community group serve events, and additional service projects as needed.

Commitment: as needed; some weekends

Suggested Gifts: administration, giving, service, helps

COMMUNICATION TEAM

Team Leader: Susanna Donald

Job description: Serve as one of the following—a social media assistant (updating sites such as Twitter and Facebook on a regular basis), event photographers (attend WordServe events, take and upload photos in a timely manner), and an E-newsletter assistant (writing and formatting content for WordServe's e-newsletter).

Commitment: depends on the role; all servants should have access to a reliable internet connection. Social media assistant should have basic knowledge of social media; E-news assistant should have good communication and computer skills.

Suggested Gifts: administration, helps

ADMINISTRATION TEAM

Team Leader: Sara Hunziker

Job description: Help make copies, write notes, prepare items for mailers, and enter information in the database.

Commitment: You will be contacted as needed to help on this team.

SET-UP AND TEAR DOWN TEAM

Team Leader: Sandie Brandenberger

Job description: Arrive early on Sunday mornings to help set up chairs, stage equipment, and children's areas. Stay after the service to pack up all equipment and return Huggins to its original set up.

Commitment: Sundays (before and after service), every other month, 7:30-8:30 am, and approximately 1 hour after the worship service.

Suggested Gifts: Serving, helps

WORDSERVE KIDS TEAM

Team Leader: Bethany Blakemore

Job description: Work in one of three children's areas: Nursery, Pre-School, or Elementary. Greet/play with children upon arrival. Lead or assist in age appropriate lessons from provided curriculum (singing, stories, etc.).

Commitment: Some preparation time (about 15 minutes per week to review the lesson), and twice monthly service: 1st and 3rd Sundays or 2nd and 4th Sundays.

Suggested Gifts: pastoring, shepherding, teaching, mercy, giving, serving

WORDSERVE YOUTH TEAM

Team Leader: Damon Stalvey

Job description: One or more of the following—work as event drivers (willing to drive for Youth events), meal preparers (provide meals for Sun. evening Youth meetings), event shoppers (buy supplies for Youth events and trips—funding provided), administrative assistants (maintaining lists of servants, meal schedules, etc.), and prayer team (praying weekly for students and leaders).

Commitment: depends on the role (for instance, prayer team will commit to praying weekly, meal preparers will be scheduled on a rotating basis, and event shoppers and drivers are as-needed.)

Suggested Gifts: serving, administration, giving, hospitality, helps

HOSPITALITY/CONNECTION TEAM

Team Leader: Damon Stalvey

Job description: Create a warm, welcoming, and hospitable environment on Sunday mornings by working in one of the following areas—set up and staff Welcome Center Table, set up and staff Refreshment Table, or act as Greeter/Usher

Commitment: serve in one of the above roles twice monthly.

Suggested Gifts: hospitality, helps, giving

PRAYER TEAM

Team Leader: Nolan Donald

Job description: Join with others and pray for God to accomplish His purposes in WordServe and the greater Fulshear/west Katy area. No experience needed.

Commitment: dedicated prayer time—can fit into any schedule; weekly commitment to pray for prayer requests (gathered on Sunday mornings)

Suggested Gifts: intercession, prophecy

WORSHIP TEAM

Team Leader: Clayton Wakefield

AUDIO/VISUAL TEAM

Job description: Help create and run PowerPoint slides for Sunday morning, and/or help run sound on Sunday morning.

Commitment: schedule to be determined by number of servants.

Suggested Gifts: service, helps (also note that basic computer skills are helpful, but most important is a willingness to learn)

PRAISE TEAM

Job description: Sing and/or play an instrument with the band on Sunday mornings.

Commitment: Practice one evening per week (to be determined), early arrival on Sundays for rehearsal
